PRAYER UPDATE:

Things are very complicated in Haiti right now. Ellie and I were supposed to be there with a team, but our flight got canceled. This is good because we all would have gotten stuck in the country in the middle of all this. All flights going in and out of the country, have ceased for safety reasons. ...

Grace Academy has been open sporadically but not at all right now. It is too dangerous for anyone to be on the streets. The teachers create homework packets each week for all the kids, and the parents pick them up. If there are guestions. Mama Edeline and the teachers have a WhatsApp group with the parents to help them, or when possible, they meet with a teacher. The teachers submit lesson plans each week to Mama Edeline as we continue to function online.

The gangs sent out a warning last week for the population to stay in their homes because, on Monday, they are going to war. They did just that yesterday (03/19/24). They are going after the rich Haitian's homes and killing them. These are the ones that many say run the country behind the scenes in an attempt to keep the poor suffering.

It is a very complicated situation. We have to remain vigilant in our prayers. We rest in our God, who is still sovereign and still reigns from His throne.
